

White Wine

Tavino Trebbiano. Italy 10.45
Pale in colour with aromas of citrus and melon which follow onto the palate with a lovely splash of zest and green apple.

Fonte do Nico Vinho Branco. France 10.45
A light fresh and zesty white. This wine has ripe citrus fruits with good minerality, structure and a lingering after taste.

Five Foot Track Chardonnay. Australia 13.00
Pale straw yellow with youthful green hues. A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate, served up with a rounded and buttery feel.

Vina Carrasco Sauvignon Blanc. Chile 13.50
Thoroughly citrusy on the nose, with fresh lime and lemon forming the aromatic backdrop. More citrus on the palate, accompanied by a riper hint of pineapple, and mouthwatering acidity.

Le Colline di San Giorgio Pinot Grigio. Italy 15.50
A vibrant Pinot Grigio that offers much more character and class than some. Showing citrus fruit flavours and subtle floral aromas. Good acidity helps create a clean, refreshing wine.

Baron De Baussac Viognier. South of France 15.00
Fresh and dry with aromas of apricots and white peach, hints of elderflower and fresh pineapple. A refreshingly crisp acidity draws it all together beautifully.

Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc. New Zealand 15.50
Very zesty on the palate with lots of lime and a nettily herbaceousness, this is an aromatic and classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing dry finish.

Caixas Albariño. Spain 20.00
A light, fresh and youthful wine, with a zesty and well defined citrus backbone, overlaid with subtle hints of stone fruits and nectar. Crisp and refreshing, yet rounded and enduring on the finish.

Chablis Cape St Martin. Burgundy 21.00
Lively and fresh with clean citrus aromas. Crisp, fruity and steely dry on the palate. The finish is long and lean.

Rosé Wine

Bois des Violettes Rosé. France 14.00
Bright and crisp, with very subtle strawberry fruit and a refreshing dryness. The small proportion of Muscat adds a dash of juicy grapeyness.

Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rosé. Italy 15.00
This wine shows why Rosé is so popular. Beautiful soft strawberry flavours with floral notes and a refreshing zing on the palate.

Red Wine

Tavino Sangiovese. Italy 10.45
Aromas of cherries, raspberry and plums follow onto the palate with juicy tannins giving a lovely smooth texture.

Fonte do Nico Vinho Tinto. France 10.45
With aromas of fresh berries, this wine is soft in the mouth, with good quality tannin structure and a pleasant finish.

Five Foot Track Shiraz. Australia 13.00
A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent and mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry and brambles.

Bottle

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Vina Carrasco Merlot. Chile 13.50
Aromas of ripe plums and strawberries, with faint notes of tomato leaf and sage. The palate has a thick and jammy feel, with soft, mature tannins and a rounded, easy style.

Flor Del Fuego Cabernet Sauvignon. Chile 13.50
Fruity flavours of plum and blackcurrant, with a cassis-like concentration, lifted by subtle green-pepper-like savoury tinges. Easy-going tannins provide a ripe and friendly mouthfeel.

Baron De Baussac Carignan. South of France 16.45
Deep and inky red in colour, the wine is crammed with black cherry fruit, lifted by subtle vanilla aromas from a touch of oak ageing. Bold, meaty tannins provide satisfying texture and length.

Capilla de Barro Malbec. Argentina 16.75
An intense red-purple colour, with an equally intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate, delivering a swathe of ripe, fresh black fruit held together by lush tannins.

San Millan Rioja, Crianza. Spain 17.00
Red cherry colour of medium intensity with violet hues. Direct and fresh nose. Aromas of ripe red fruits with a subtle floral bouquet and notes of cinnamon and clove. In mouth soft but with body and structure.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Puits Neuf. Rhône 25.00
With typical Chateuneuf power, the wine delivers a fresh and spicy nose of red cherry embellished with notes of sage and wild thyme. The palate is equally powerful, with sinuous tannins and huge length.

Sparkling Wine & Champagne

Codorníu Brut NV. Spain 17.00
A dry light bodied Cava displaying green apple, citrus, almond and brioche characters.

Prosecco La Gioiosa Etamarosa NV DOC Treviso 22.00
Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.

J de Telmont Grande Réserve NV. 28.00
One of the few remaining, family owned Champagne houses, De Telmont produces this excellent non-vintage in a medium bodied, soft and fruity, classically yeasty style. Fabulous value.

Oeil de Perdrix Rosé NV. 35.00
Meaning 'eye of the partridge', this pale salmon pink rosé Champagne exhibits enticing complexity. Delicate in style, but with a perfect weight of fruit. A fantastic apéritif.

Laurent-Perrier Brut NV. 45.00
A lighter house style. Subtle citrus, toast and spice predominate this perfectly balanced Champagne, with a strong structure giving the wine good food compatibility.
