WHITE WINES

La Source Reserve Blanc, Pays d'Oc, France 2020 / £18.50

Based on Grenache Blanc, this white wine has all the southern character, plenty of white fruits, white flowers and a whiff of sea salt. Versatile and easy drinking.

Goleta Sauvignon Blanc, Valle, Central Chile 2020 / £21.50

A classical Sauvignon Blanc, refreshing with crisp acidity with bright aromas of citrus fruits.

Black Cottage Sauvignon Blanc, Earth Series, Marlborough, New Zealand 2020 / £27.00

Textbook Sauvignon from Marlborough, showcasing passion fruit, nettles and plenty of goosberries. Dry and crisp with a refreshing citrus finish.

Picpoul de Pinet 'Les Courtelles', Languedoc, France 2020 / £27.00

Grown in the south of France, this classic Picpoul, has plenty of lime and pineapple notes, on the palate is dry with a hint of saltiness, given by the mediterranea sea.

Arbos Pinot Grigio, Organic, Castellani. Sicily, Italy 2020 / £27.00

This Pinot Grigio is made from 100%organic grapes, showing plenty of ripe apples, pears and melon. Great texture and plesant richness on the mid palate. Dry and elegant

Azumbre Verdejo, Cuatro Rayas, Rueda, Spain 2019 / £27.00

Made from Verdejo in the region of rueda in central Spain, it shows intense notes of almonds with a whiff of lemon peel and flowers. Dry and crisp on the palate, it's a great wine to drink as an aperitif.

RED WINES

La Source Reserve Rouge, Pays d'Oc, France 2018 / £18.50

Made from a blend of Grenache, Carigna and Syrah, this juicy and red berry driven red, has plenty of jammy plums and blackberry notes, followed by a whiff of spices and very round soft tannins.

Goleta Merlot, Valle, Central Chile 2020 / £21.50

A beautiful easy drinking fruity red with juicy plums, blackcurrant and soft tannins.

Laztana Crianza Rioja DOCa, Bodegas Olarra, Spain 2018 / £36.00

Textbook Rioja made from Tempranillo, meaty and savoury, undertones of cherries and black pepper. Well balanced and spicy on the palate.

Monteguelfo Chianti DOCG, Famiglia Cecchi, Tuscany, Italy 2018 / £25.00

Rustic and leathery, this Chianti is made from Sangiovese grapes harvested on the hills of Tuscany. It shows great notes of Morello cherries, dark plums and a hint of leather. Great all rounder and very versatile wine.

Domaine Les Goubert, Côtes du Rhône, Rhône Valley, France 2019 / £29.50

Made from Grenache, Syrah and Carignan, this CDR has plenty of spiced red forest fruits on the nose, followed by a rich and intense mouthful, complex and very intense.

Six Poets Cabernet Sauvignon, California, USA 2017 / £24.50

Typical, jammy and fruit driven Cabernet from sunny California, exhibiting rich and voluptuos notes of bramble fruits, summer fruits pudding and blackberry jam.

ROSÉ WINES

Magali Signature Rosé, Côtes de Provence, Figuière-Provence, France 2020 / £36.00

Stunning classic pale Provence style rose, showing plenty of cherry stone freshness, pink grapefruits and an elegant long finish.

Rodeiro Rosado, Bodegas Gallegas, Spain 2018 / £21.00

This Tempranillo driven rose, is full of jammy notes of strawberries and pomegranate. Dry and fresh on the palate, it's an easy drinking and very easy to drink rose.

The Palm by Whispering Angel, Rose, Chateau d'Esclans, Coteaux d'Aix en Provence, France 2020 / £42.00

Made from the most famous producer of rose in the world, this rose has all the pedegree of a top Provence. Packed with delicious red forest fruits, crunchy berries and red flowers. Sunshine in a glass!

SPARKLING WINES

Prosecco Spumante Brut Demeter DOC, Biodynamic, Tenuta Cirvanetta, Fidora, Veneto, Italy NV / £25.50

Organic and biodynamic Prosecco from the best sun kissed vineyards, showing plenty of classic apples and peaches notes. Great as an aperitif.

Prosecco Rose Brut Nature, Organic, Tenuta Civranetta, Fidora, Veneto, Italy 2019 / £27.50

Packed with freshly cut wild berries, this outstanding Prosecco rose is dry and vibrant with plenty of cherry stone freshness and red currants.

Champagne Rimbaud Brut, France NV / £45.00

Made from a traditional blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier, it shows stunning notes of fresh toasted bread and brioche, lots of citrus notes on the palate and a ripe pineapple finish.

Champagne Rimbaud Brut Rosé, France NV / £56.00

Elegant and well poised Pinot driven rose, showing plenty of wild berries notes and red flowers on the nose, dry and well poised on the palate with plenty of velvety and juicy strawberries and raspberries.
